***Key Concerns Snapshot**

- Severely cloudy drinking water. Bottle water should be distributed daily. Commissioners felt strongly they would not feel comfortable drinking the only water the incarcerated individuals had access to.
- Concerns regarding lack dignity affirming care for transpeople incarcerated at this facility due to not receiving razors in indigen kits
- Mold exposure concerns, people feeling symptomatic, and continuous practice of painting over mold, especially near showers

***General**

- Kellie Johnson from AEO accompanied this inspection upon request of the Chair & Co-Chair
- use of force: couple sprays last couple of day per the Watch Commander
- elevators working

***1400-1**

- Deputy Vergara conducting Title 15 checks but did not look into the cells when scanning
- Flooding on the floor [REDACTED] - gave her sub toxin prior to court which made her too tired to go to court. Unfortunately, she missed her court date due to this. Shared that she inquired about not taking it to no avail
- 7 phones and all of them are grainy

***Details from Trustees who reside in 1700 (working dorm) and were working the intake area during inspection. Commissioners did not go to 1700 on this inspection. Trustees reported that...**

- water still brown, there are bugs, and some people have gotten sick from the conditions
- toilets clogged & worms in showers
- Only getting one blanket and are regularly cold
- Have not had toilet paper in a week days
- There was a covid outbreak and people with symptoms were put in the disciplinary area and had their showers limited
- Weren't given any medicine during the time period when they had COVID
- Received the same blankets back after they had COVID
- [REDACTED] needs to see an dentist and the doctor for a medication refill
- [REDACTED] needs dental care
- Only get linen exchange once a week
- 5 toilets were clogged for 3 weeks

- [REDACTED] needs medical visit
- Mr. Sanchez moved one of the women who was previously sexually assaulted back to K-10 which is the unit where the assault occurred, after she spoke to the ACLU
- Ceiling mold is better and was treated
- Some of the women were concerned because they were out in the main area for programming while the mold was being treated. They proceeded to not feel good. Some shared with deputies but because of COVID in other dorms, they did not want to share if they were having symptoms from the mold exposure out of fear for being quarantined to the discipline area.
- Request for masks when the mold was being cleaned but did not receive
- One of the air vents is leaking which is causing rust and one of the women in the dorm was experiencing a skin rash
- They are still experiencing mail issues. When raised to Senior Alfara, he told them that their families were lying. They had not received mail since May
- Cell #3 has mold all over and water/liquid dripping down the wall
- [REDACTED] needs medical attention for her asthma and has been feeling dizzy from the mold
- [REDACTED] needs medical attention and also feels sick from the mold
- Cell 17 the #toilet is leaking
- Cell #16 the toilet was leaking
- Cell #24 toilet leak/water comes out
- Cells #24-48 on the top row have no AC and the sinks are clogged and have worms
- Phones mostly work
- One person reported not getting new blankets for 5 months [REDACTED]
- Cell #5 needs new blanket and only has 1. Also there are flies in the water
- Many UTI reports. Need new underwear
- Meat is rancid
- A vegan individual shared that the vegetables are regularly not cooked for their meal
- Not receiving trash bags from trustees
- Grateful for officer Martinez who actually sprays the mold with bleach
- Stopped indigen kits 3 weeks ago
- [REDACTED] needs new eye wear and also had concerns about conflicting meds being prescribed to him at the same time
- Deputy Nelson has an open investigation for his actions in module but he continues to find reasons to transfer people in and out of that dorm and the women feel it is an intimidation tactic
