Century Regional Detention Center (CRDF) Inspection Report

I. Summary of Inspection

Commissioners conducted an unannounced inspection of Century Regional Detention Center (CRDF) to assess facility conditions, inmate welfare, and staff practices. The inspection focused on water safety, environmental hazards, staff conduct, and procedural issues related to property searches, grievance handling, and medical access.

While consulting with the Watch Commander (WC), commissioners observed a note on the office board indicating that staff property searches are conducted approximately six shift times each week. The WC clarified that these searches involve visual inspections of deputies' clear backpacks and belongings only, and no physical or scanned body searches are conducted. A canine unit assists approximately once per week. If an item inconsistent with policy is discovered, staff are instructed to return it to their vehicle, rather than face disciplinary action.

The WC also noted that the facility remains below capacity and that the brown, discolored water issue continues throughout the facility, pending completion of city-led repiping/sewer work.

II. Observations

Pod 1700

Ant Infestation: Ongoing for approximately two months, particularly in the lower level, which is currently vacant.

Lactation Program: Incarcerated mother of twins reported that her bottled water was confiscated two days prior despite ongoing need to pump milk. Lack of access poses potential health risks, including engorgement and mastitis. WC agreed to follow up with medical staff regarding reinstatement.

Structural Damage: Roof above a top-tier bunk is collapsing. Staff use a trash can to catch leaks when it rains.

Triple-Bunking: Beds are closely spaced; commissioners requested clarification on spacing policy.

Blanket Confiscation: Recent searches resulted in the confiscation of extra blankets, leaving some inmates cold. WC confirmed Title 15 standards remain unchanged; however, communication about the process was unclear.

Quarantine Practices: Women in quarantine must bring their blankets back and forth instead of being issued clean ones.

Property Grievance: Incarcerated woman reported her purchased washcloth, confiscated on September 28, has not been returned. The grievance response indicated additional investigation time required.

Staff Conduct: Most deputies were reported to be respectful, though one was described as making repeated rude and sarcastic remarks toward women.

Medical Access: Slight improvement noted, but delays persist. Incarcerated women reported waiting several months for dental care.

Programming: Educational and rehabilitative opportunities remain accessible and encouraged.

Pod 2600

Water Quality: Persistent brown and chlorine-smelling water. Multiple sinks have been running continuously for weeks.

Plumbing and Ventilation: Cell #24 lacks hot water; Cells #21 and #22 emit strong sewer odors. Vents circulate only cold air.

Mold and Rust: Black and green mold visible on ceilings and in showers. Some areas appear painted over rather than properly cleaned.

Hygiene Access: Shortages of razors, hygiene kits, and clean laundry persist; women report being forced to reuse dirty clothing and blankets.

Deputy Misconduct: Multiple reports allege a deputy observes women showering from the lower level, escorts women while leaving them exposed in shower, and makes them wait unclothed before returning to their cells. Fear of retaliation deters reporting.

Water Restrictions: Bottled water remains prohibited despite poor water quality. Incarcerated woman in quarantine reported inability to order water despite medical needs.

PREA Complaint: Incarcerated woman previously filed a PREA complaint against Deputy for voyeuristic behavior while she showered in Pod 1600. Commissioners noted the investigative process appeared non-trauma-informed and potentially discouraging for survivors.

Temperature and Airflow: Poor air circulation creates extreme hot and cold conditions.

C. Inmate Reception Center (IRC)

Access to Food and Water: Seven to eight women in holding reported no access to dinner or water at time of inspection. One pregnant woman specifically requested water without response.

Communication: Detainees expressed anxiety and confusion about housing status after waiting several hours without updates.

Staff Response: Intake deputies were directed to provide access to water and communicate updated housing information.

III. Key Findings

Water Safety Concerns: Persistent brown, odorous water remains unresolved despite ongoing city plan to re-pipe water lines; incarcerated woman denied bottled water while staff bring personal water.

Environmental Hazards: Mold, rust, leaks, and structural deterioration pose ongoing health and safety risks.

Inadequate Medical and Hygiene Access: Extended delays for medical care, limited hygiene supplies, and inconsistent blanket distribution continue.

Staff Conduct Issues: Reports of inappropriate visual monitoring and disrespectful behavior highlight the need for PREA-compliant and trauma-informed training.

Ineffective Grievance System: Inmates report delays, dismissive responses, and unclear communication.

Unclear Search Procedures: Frequent staff property searches occur without scanning or documentation, raising questions about efficacy and transparency.

Intake Conditions: Lack of basic needs and information for newly admitted women continues to be a recurring issue.

IV. Recommendations

Water Quality Mitigation: Provide bottled or filtered water to incarcerated until re-piping is completed.

Environmental Health Assessment: Conduct an independent environmental safety inspection for mold, leaks, and structural damage.

Medical and Hygiene Access: Ensure timely access to medical, dental, and hygiene supplies in compliance with Title 15.

Staff Training and Accountability: Reinforce trauma-informed practices and PREA compliance; investigate all allegations of voyeurism or harassment.

Grievance System Reform: Improve timeliness and transparency of grievance responses, with tracking and oversight.

Intake Conditions: Mandate immediate access to water, meals, and updates on housing for all individuals in holding cells.

Communication and Policy Clarity: Ensure incarcerated females receive clear, written communication regarding blanket, property, and water policies.
