87. Narrative Report

We began this inspection unable to access the facility, as we were told that one of the inspector's credentials were no longer valid. After much back and forth and confirmation that the inspector's access credentials were indeed valid, we were allowed to enter TTCF. The Watch Commander was not available to meet with the inspectors. We met briefly with Sergeant Lindenmayer instead and received information on the count.

We heard multiple concerning medical needs on our inspection, including:

- Concerns about diabetes not being appropriately handled
- Concerns about cancer treatment not received
- Multiple dental issues
- A broken nose (with blood still on the floor of cell), not receiving medication/care
- Possible COVID-19 infection

As always, we were very happy to see the successes of the FIP Stepdown units -- whose units are colorful, bright, and helpful for their patients. We hope to see a continuation of this program, and an expansion as it is effective and a positive step in the right direction.

In 171, Netflix was on in the deputy area and we were told they do not have enough staff to do proper HOH Title 15 checks as they need more staff. We were told by those incarcerated in this unit that they were hungry. No grievance or medical forms were available in the common areas. We received multiple requests for books, toothbrushes, combs.
