Flies appeared to have hatched and IP wants the cell to be cleaned. This individual did not appear to have more trash than other people. Grievance form filled out and delivered to WC.

One person reported he had been in 142 Charlie 1 for over 12 days without a functional toilet before they moved him to his current cell in 142 Alpha. The toilet in his current cell works.

Showers not provided to IPs for several days. The shower has reportedly been clogged and dirty, so the pod has not received showers for the past 4 days. Commissioners ran the shower in A-pod; it appeared functional and clean, but deputies reported that it floods if it runs too long. Deputies reported they would document in the UDAL that showers were skipped.

142A and C: Several people reported that they do not receive showers every other day as required by Title 15. One gentleman reported he just moved to the module on Tuesday, and had not received a shower yet, even though he should've received one on Wednesday and today, Friday.

·Several people reported the shower was flooded, so they did not receive showers that day. It had been flooded, and a work order was apparently submitted, but there was nothing indicating the shower was flooded. Commissioner Veral turned on the water and let it run in the shower did not flood.

One person not taken to arraignment because the Deputy decided IP wasn't ready fast enough, but blamed it on bus issues. Resulted in not being arraigned for 7 days. Supposed to have phone privileges every other day, but because of Dep, has not had the phone today.

A transwoman in the module is requesting a transfer to CRDF due to highly offensive language from the Deputy, including being called "fa\*\*\*\*", told that "dudes stay in these jails" and called a "n\*\*\*\*\*" when she needed more time to scrub her back in the shower

One individual, we spoke to was concerned that his cell would be tossed up after speaking with him so he was concerned about being forthcoming.

The Deputy was also observed by Commissioners to be dismissive of issues brought to the deputies' attention. Deputy's name was reported to Watch Commander and other LASD staff
