117. Narrative Report

The commissioners were asked by one IP, "why do the deputies speak to me like i am a bad child? why can't they treat me with any kindness at all?"

In one cell, an IP complained of being covered with bug bites and bugs crawling all over the cell. She needed new bedding and had not been allowed out to shower since her arrival.

Many IPs in 1400 told us that when they first arrived, their cells were filthy, full of bugs, crumbs, urine, feces/biohazard and they were not provided any cleaning supplies and told to stay in there without complaining. Many said they were not getting regular phone calls or showers.

We spoke with a trustee who said things were "terrible for (her)" and that she was given too much to do with too little support and put on the line for issues that were beyond her control. She said she was told to say there was no food left when there was food left by the deputy, when people asked for seconds.

When an IP asked for dinner, the IP told commissioners that a deputy told her "You shouldn't have come to jail if you wanted food. You're not getting any."

The module was very dirty with trash everywhere.

We observed dinner being passed out and observed some cells skipped and followed up, asking them to bring those cells trays as well.

When we spoke with a deputy, she told us that:

- There is a general sock shortage at CRDF
- FISH kits are given out before women come to IRC
- Women use the bras they are given to clean their cells so they do not have more available.
- Phone calls/showers are available to women "after they cool off and are calmer" IF there are enough personnel, because they are "too hostile."
