123. Narrative Report

Commissioners conducted a facility inspection, including interviews with incarcerated persons, walkthroughs of housing units, medical areas, outdoor recreation logs, and visitation spaces. While no PREA reports or use-of-force incidents were reported during the review period, numerous concerns were identified regarding facility conditions, medical care, grievance accessibility, sanitation, water quality, food quality, privacy concerns, and allegations of staff misconduct and retaliation. Recurring themes included reports of mold, rust, sewage odors, contaminated water, limited access to grievance forms, delayed medical care, inadequate accommodations for individuals with medical needs, and ongoing allegations that male deputies observe incarcerated women while showering.

Security and Operations:

Elevators operational.
Narcan available throughout housing units.
Majority of deputies equipped with body-worn cameras.
Newly assigned deputies/cadets are not yet equipped with body cameras pending training.

Use of Force

No use-of-force incidents reported during the review period.
One incident involved preparation for a controlled resistance hold; force was ultimately not utilized.

PREA

No PREA complaints reported during the reporting period.
Grievance System Concerns

Commissioners identified significant concerns regarding access to and processing of grievances:

No blank grievance forms readily available in multiple housing units.
Deputies often needed to print grievance forms upon request.
New grievance forms reportedly limit incarcerated persons to:
-Two grievances per week.
-Four grievances per month.
-Carbon-copy tracking system removed.
-Reduced space available to document concerns.
Multiple reports that grievances receive no response.
Reports that supervisors open grievances in front of staff.
Allegations that staff retaliate against incarcerated persons after grievance submission.

Food, Nutrition, and Water Concerns

Privacy and Staff Conduct Concerns

Multiple incarcerated persons reported:

- Male deputies observing women while showering.
- Deputies delaying opening show
- Deputies standing on chairs or positioning themselves to observe showers.
- Excessive or prolonged physical searches.
- Dismissive responses to medical concerns.
- Retaliation following grievance submissions.

Staff members specifically identified in allegations included:

- Deputy Padilla
- Deputy Lopez
- Deputy Barrera
- Deputy Gamez

These allegations warrant further investigation.

Recreation and Programming

Commissioners reviewed recreation logs and observed:

- Limited access to outdoor recreation.
- Only selected housing areas receiving access to outdoor space.
- No programming available during certain scheduled periods.
- Inconsistent access across housing locations.

Medical Concerns-General Findings

Recurring concerns included:

- Delayed medical treatment.
- Delayed medication administration.
- Failure to respond to medical requests.
- Delayed specialty care.
- Inadequate chronic disease management.
- Failure to provide approved accommodations.
- Inadequate detoxification support.

Reports being denied medical evaluation and access to the grievance process following the incident.

Incarcerated Person-D

Reports undergoing involuntary withdrawal from methamphetamine.
States she was assigned to a top bunk while experiencing withdrawal symptoms.
Reports falling from the bunk and sustaining an ankle fracture.
States medical treatment was delayed following the injury.
Reports continued visible swelling of the ankle.
Requests assignment to a lower bunk due to medical concerns.

Additional follow-up requested for multiple incarcerated persons reporting chronic pain, respiratory concerns, neurological symptoms, gastrointestinal issues, and access to prescribed medical devices.

Visitation Area Observations

Commissioners observed:

Broken visitation phone.
Significant ceiling stains suggesting possible leaks.
Areas potentially containing mold.
Inconsistent signage throughout visitation areas.
Extremely cold visitation environment.

Recommendations:

Conduct comprehensive mold, plumbing, and environmental health assessment.
Review water quality throughout affected housing units.
Investigate allegations regarding shower privacy violations.
Review grievance policy changes and accessibility concerns.
Ensure all approved medical accommodations are provided promptly.
Conduct review of medical response procedures and medication delivery practices.
Assess food quality and dietary compliance.
Increase access to hygiene supplies and laundry services.
Evaluate staff conduct allegations and retaliation claims.
Review outdoor recreation access and programming opportunities for all housing units.
Address maintenance deficiencies involving ventilation, plumbing, showers, visitation areas, and housing infrastructure.

Conclusion:

The inspection identified significant concerns regarding environmental health conditions, grievance accessibility, medical care, sanitation, privacy protections, and staff conduct. While facility operations appeared generally stable from a security perspective, immediate attention is warranted to address ongoing health, safety, and quality-of-life concerns reported by incarcerated persons and observed during the inspection.
