## 116. Narrative Report

### Inspection Summary

Commissioners conducted an inspection of multiple housing locations within Twin Towers Correctional Facility, including general population housing, the Correctional Treatment Center (CTC), Suicide Watch Housing, and High Observation Housing (HOH). Interviews were conducted with incarcerated persons regarding living conditions, medical care, mental health services, access to programming, and grievance concerns.

#### Housing Conditions

Module 262-D

Cell #14

Cell observed to be unsanitary.

Cell #12L

Significant accumulation of dust and debris observed around the cell door.

Cell appeared in need of cleaning.

Individual Concerns

Medical Concerns

#### Incarcerated Person A

Reported developing an infection on the left torso and left index finger since housing placement.

Stated housing area is dirty and unsanitary and believes conditions contributed to medical concerns.

#### Incarcerated Person B

Reported:

Persistent ankle swelling.

States medical concerns have not been adequately addressed.

Has submitted multiple grievances and receives signed/date-stamped grievance receipts.

Requested a Bible but reports never receiving one.

Correctional Treatment Center (CTC)

Commissioners conducted a follow-up interview regarding an incarcerated person previously assaulted at North County Correctional Facility (Wayside) in May 2026.

Reported concerns include:

Multiple surgical appointments reportedly cancelled.

Ongoing stress regarding delayed medical care.

Jaw continues healing following assault.

Experiencing vertigo preventing ability to lie flat.

Scheduled neurology appointment on June 23, 2026.

Scheduled court appearance on June 24, 2026.

Reports being incarcerated approximately sixteen months without trial.

States he has no access to the law library.

Reports court-ordered restriction on telephone calls.

Reports not receiving legal mail.

#### Suicide Watch Housing (262-D)

Medication distribution occurring appropriately.

Cells generally operational.

Mental Health Concerns

One incarcerated person reported:

Feeling pressured by mental health staff to accept reclassification.

Alleged disrespectful comments during psychiatric evaluations regarding suicide prevention clothing.

Expressed fear of being transferred to a less safe housing location.

Has remained on suicide watch since approximately May 21, 2026.

Wishes to remain housed in a safe environment until clinically appropriate.

Dayroom television has not functioned for an extended period due to lack of signal.

Shower schedule limited to Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Trustees are inconsistent or unavailable to adequately clean housing areas.

One incarcerated person reported:  
Believes he was denied attendance at an outside therapeutic group.  
Unsure whether exclusion was retaliatory after asking staff questions.  
Recently transferred from Housing Unit 241-B approximately one week prior.  
Reported untreated sinus symptoms leading him to flood his cell in an effort to obtain medical attention.

Described asking calmly why he was unable to attend group and perceived the deputy's response as rude.  
Continues requesting medical evaluation for sinus issues and dental concerns.  
Requested commission follow-up regarding access to treatment and programming.

Deputy Bello Assisted commissioners with navigation to the Correctional Treatment Center. he was calm and professional, helpful in answering questions, and respectful during interactions. This interaction reflected professional communication and cooperation during the inspection.

#### Recommendations

Evaluate sanitation concerns within Housing Unit 262, including dirty cells, accumulated dust, and mattress conditions.  
Review reported delays in medical evaluation, specialty appointments, and ongoing treatment requests.  
Investigate reports of cancelled surgical appointments and barriers to specialty medical care.  
Assess reports regarding access to legal mail, law library services, and court-related resources.  
Review mental health interactions and classification concerns raised within Suicide Watch Housing.  
Restore or repair dayroom televisions in affected housing units.  
Address commissary shortages reported in High Observation Housing.  
Review procedures regarding access to therapeutic groups and ensure programming decisions are communicated clearly.  
Follow up on requests for religious materials, including Bibles.  
Continue recognizing professional staff interactions that promote respectful communication and positive engagement with incarcerated persons.
