5. Approval of Legislative Ad Hoc Committee

Commission Vice Chair Salcido presented on the legislative tracking process and the work accomplished by last year's Legislative Ad Hoc Committee. She advocated for the reestablishment of a Legislative Ad Hoc Committee during this year's legislative session, given the expected climate-related bills. Commissioner Jaipersaud motioned to approve the establishment of the Legislative Ad Hoc Committee and second by Commissioner Diaz. Commissioners Riley, Hernandez, Diaz, Jaipersaud, Patel, and Salcido all self-nominated to join the committee. Additional self-nominations remained open to Commissioners via email following the meeting.

6. 2025 Work Plan Implementation and Community Engagement

Victoria Simon reviewed the 2025 Work Plan, highlighting the three primary areas of focus – OurCounty Update input, District Coalitions, and Engagement with the Supervisors' Offices and Departments. Commissioners had breakouts for each district to discuss how to engage with youth in their district and identify dates for tabling and district coalition meetings. District Coalition webinar dates were identified as March 12, June 5, September 4, and December 12 from 4:30pm – 6pm. Commissioner Riley suggested organizing a YCC event for LA Climate Week, which Commissioner Jennings and Chair Patel expressed support for.

The YCC Social was postponed due to the LA wildfires, but it will be rescheduled in February depending on availability.
