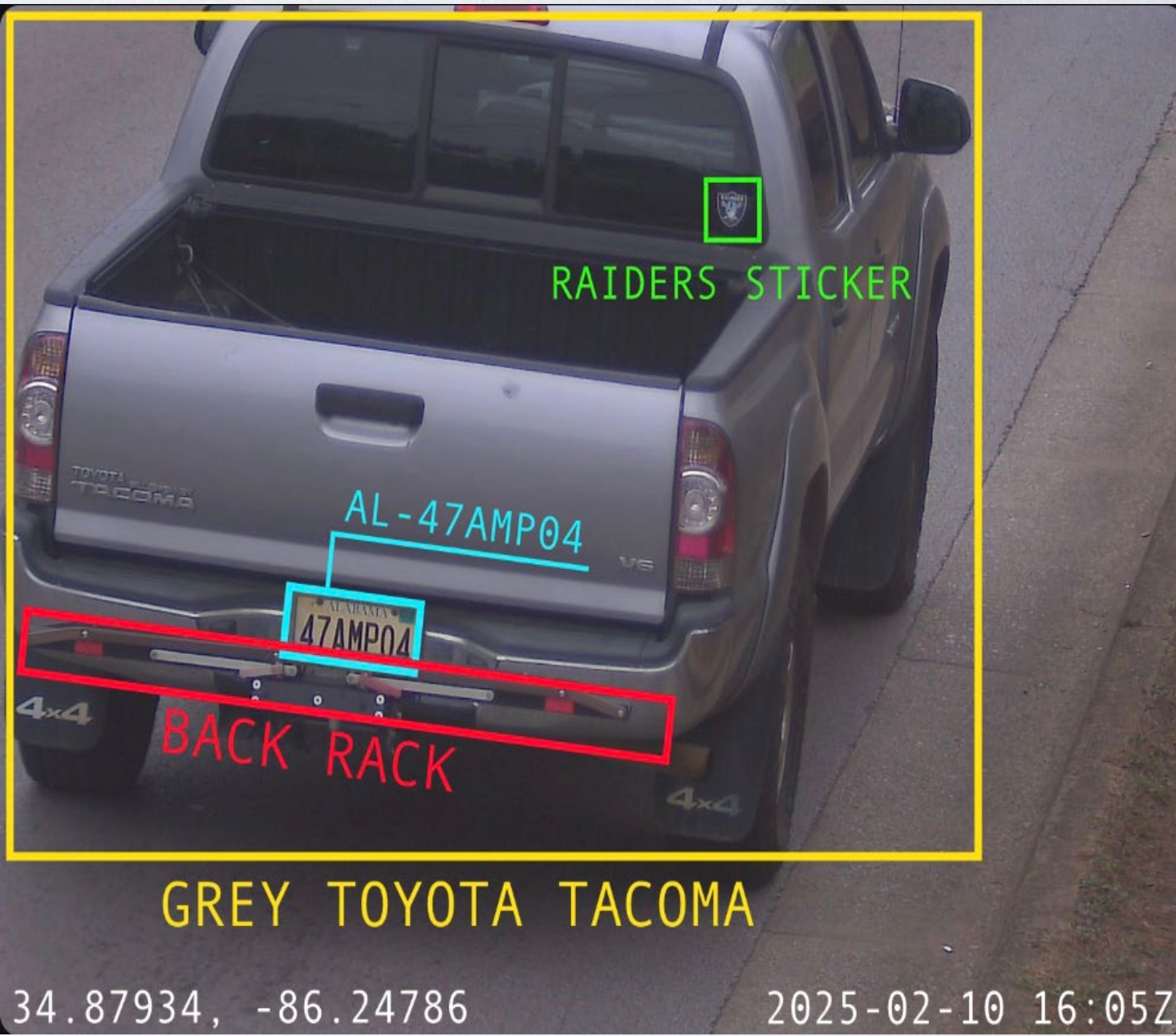

<< Traditional ALPR Images

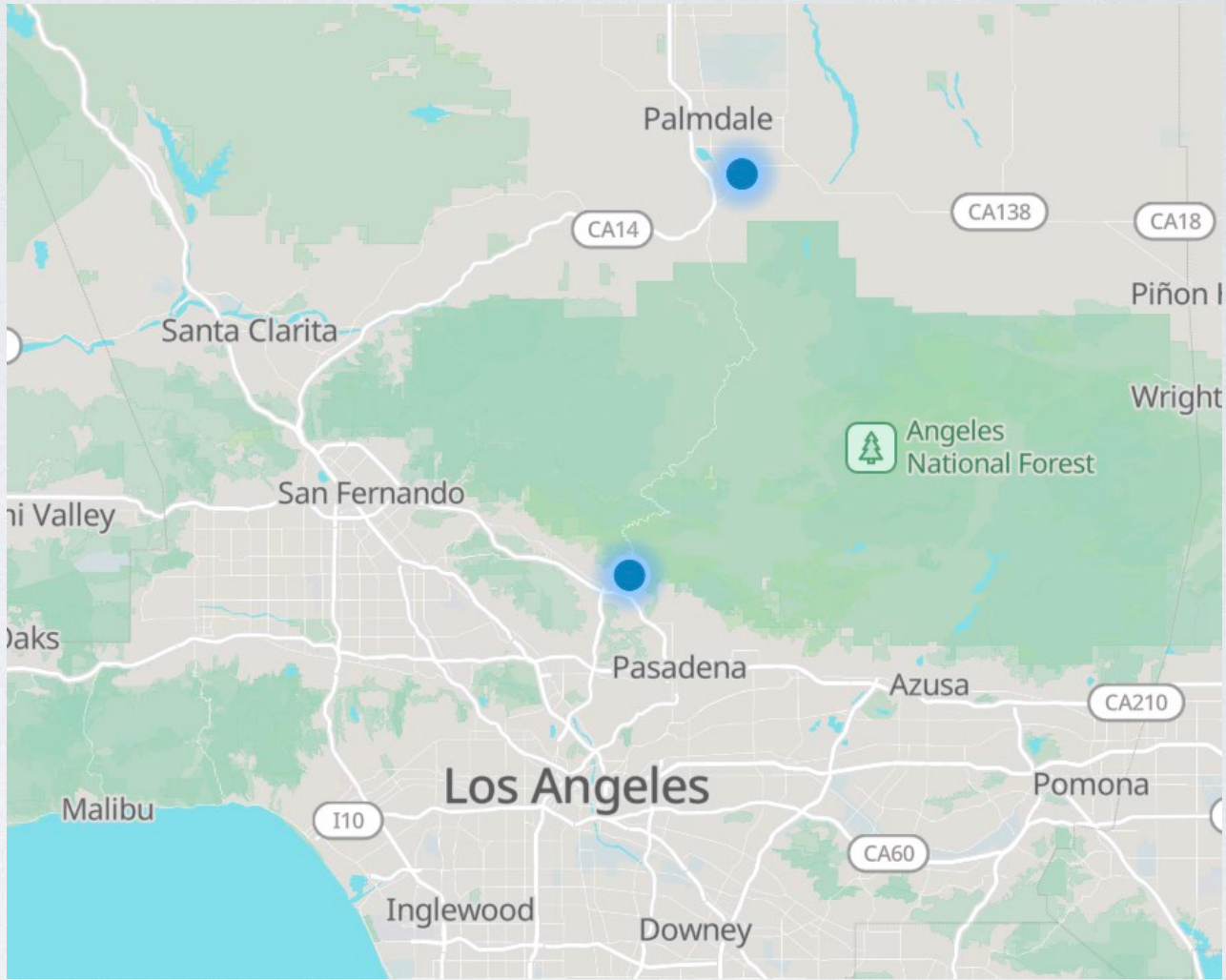

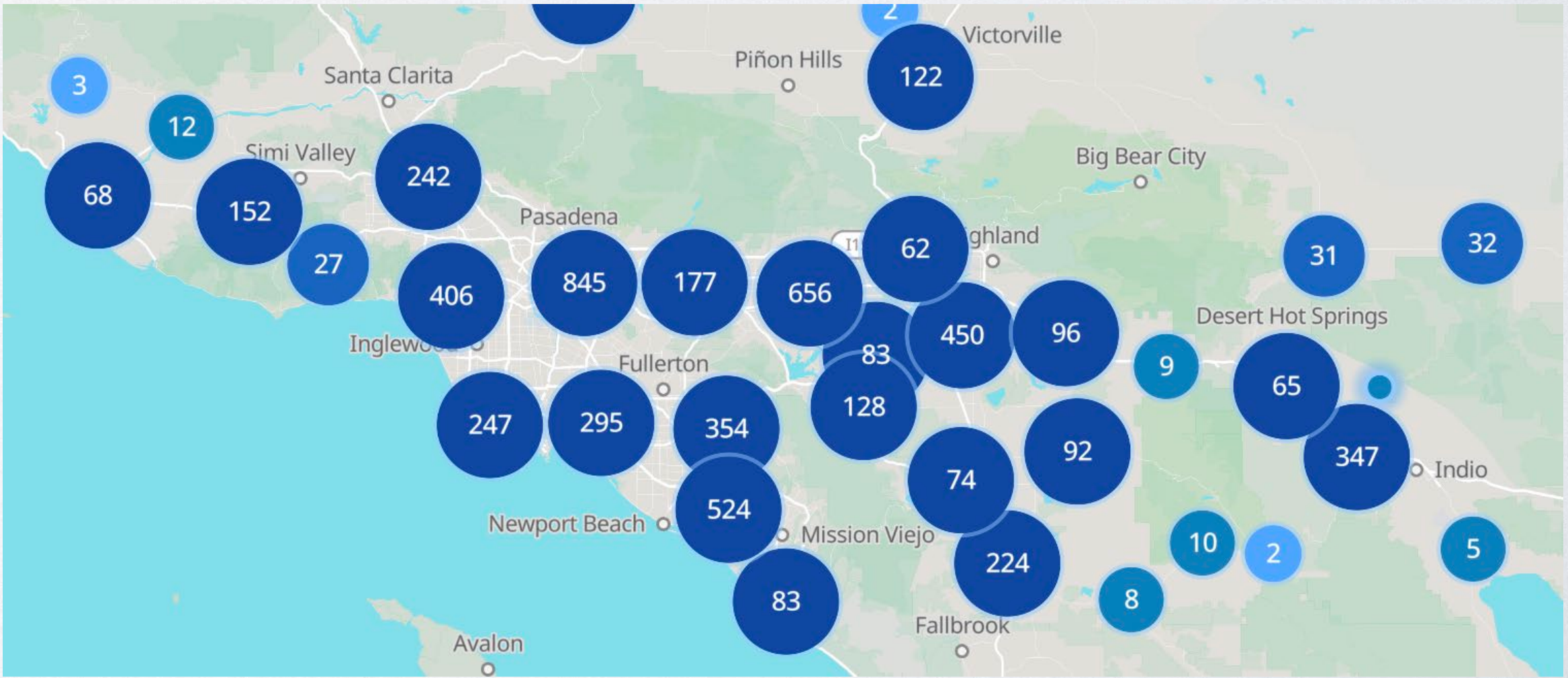
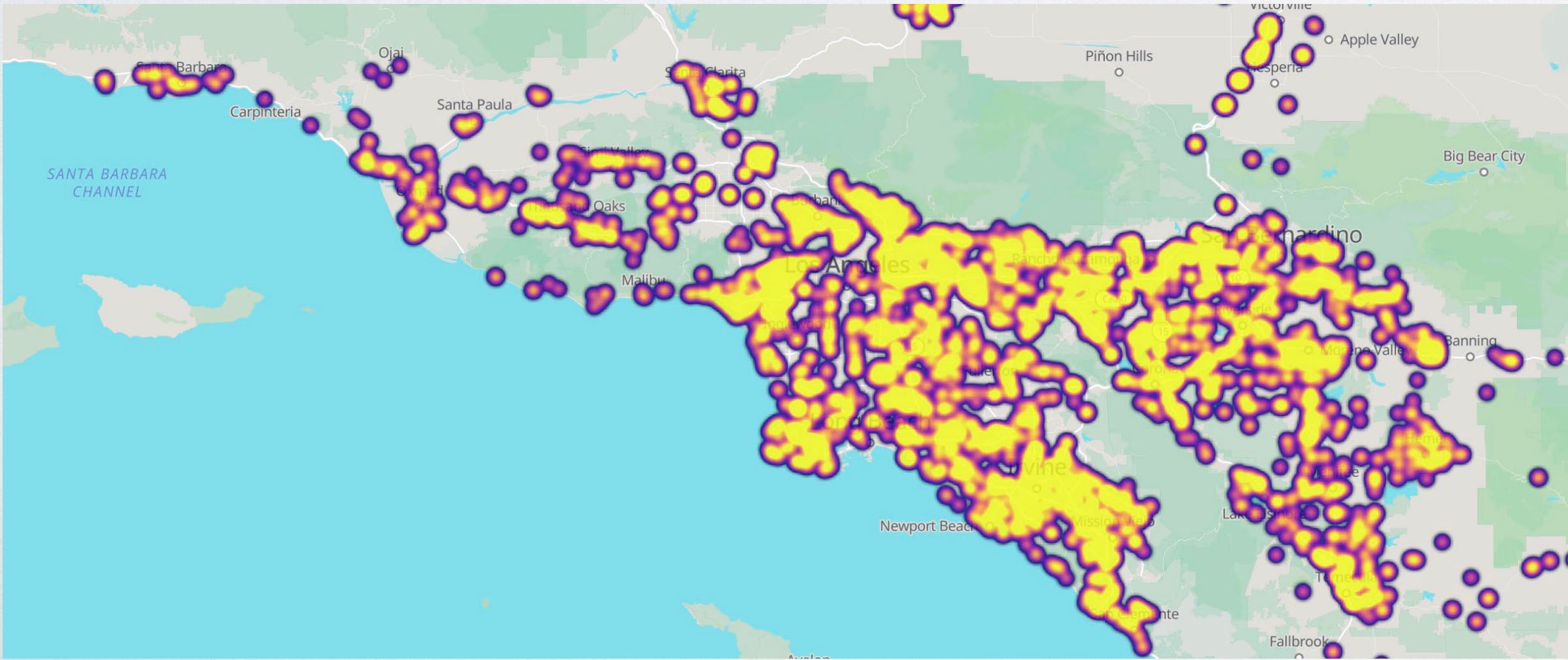


Heat map of reported ALPRs in US and LA

OVERVIEW OF REQUESTED POLICY CHANGES

- September 2025 - LA County Board of Supervisors passes motion requesting changes to LASD's license plate reader policy
- Key motion requests:
 - (1) prohibit use of data in civil immigration enforcement
 - (2) keep log of all database searches + reason for search (as required by state law) & provide report to county summarizing these logs 2x/year
 - (3) complete annual trainings on CA sanctuary laws and ALPR privacy laws
 - (4) terminate data-sharing agreements that violate state law
 - (5) follow Office of Inspector General's policy suggestions from August 2025:
 - (i) ban sharing data with federal agencies
 - (ii) audit the logs of searches to prevent database misuse
 - (iii) not enter permanent data-sharing agreements
 - (iv) reconsider the 5-year plate data retention period **Note, in March 2026, LASD revised their policy to shorten this to 2 years

KEY QUESTIONS TO ASK

What data does the Sheriff Department collect and in which formats?

Why does the Sheriff Department store your data for so long?

How do you ensure that your data was deleted?

How often does the Department share your data with others, including through fusion centers?

How many ALPRs does the Department operate, and where are they?

Which third party companies do they license the cameras from?

Which third party companies do they buy data-search software from?

How often has ALPR data assisted the Department in apprehending suspects in total?
