## MOTION BY SUPERVISORS JANICE HAHN AND KATHRYN BARGER

September 12, 2017

On February 21, 2017 the Board instructed the Chief Probation Officer, in coordination with County Counsel, the Chief Executive Officer, the revocation courts, and other relevant agencies to provide a report back to the Board with background information relating to the alleged gunman responsible for the February 20 shooting death of Whittier Police Officer Keith Boyer. Some of the information sought is confidential and protected by state law from release, such as details of the criminal history of the alleged gunman as well as his inmate history while incarcerated in California state prison. Other information obtained through the criminal investigation may also be confidential and will not be subject to release. We must comply with state law in this regard and redact that type of information from any publicly-disseminated document. However, the motion also called for a procedural and policy overview, and I commend the Probation Department and the County for looking within to identify systemic issues that might be improved in the wake of this tragedy. Yet I believe we have a further responsibility to inform the public about activities undertaken on their behalf, along with efforts made to improve and enhance outcomes, particularly when it -MORE-
