

Establish the Reward Offer for the Murder of Laron Follings

On Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at approximately 6:57 p.m., 30-year-old Laron Follings was shot while seated in his parked vehicle on the 1500 block of East 123rd Street in the unincorporated area of Willowbrook. Mr. Follings sustained several gunshot wounds and later died from his injuries. A witness heard gunshots and observed a male near the center divider of East 123rd Street. The male entered a newer model black four-door sedan and proceeded eastbound on East 123rd Street and out of view.

Mr. Follings worked as a full-time security guard and was in the process of obtaining his real estate license. He is survived by his mother, father, and two siblings. The victim’s mother, along with other family members, have requested a reward offer for information surrounding the circumstances of her son’s murder.

Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department (LASD) investigators believe a reward would bring attention to the case and encourage witnesses that might have seen and/or know the identity of the suspect(s) to come forward. A reward would help with identifying the suspect(s) and bring justice to the victim and his family. Any individuals with information about this crime are urged to contact LASD or Crime Stoppers.

Establish the offer of a reward in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the heinous murder of Laron Follings, who was fatally shot on January 5, 2021, at approximately 6:57
