**Reward Extension in the Suspicious Disappearance of Gloria Huerta**

On Monday, August 3, 2020, 27-year-old Gloria Huerta also known as “Jessica” was reported missing to the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department. It is reported Ms. Huerta was last seen on the 14700 block of East Avenue Q-14 in the City of Palmdale. Ms. Huerta is described as a Hispanic female, four-foot-eleven, 100 pounds, with brown eyes and brown hair.

LASD investigators believe an altercation occurred on the property where Ms. Huerta was staying in her trailer and believe foul play is involved. The trailer has also been reported missing and is described as an approximately 15 to 20-foot white trailer, with no markings and with the door towards the rear.

Ms. Huerta’s family and friends are extremely concerned for her safety and are pleading with the public for any information that will lead to her safe return home. LASD investigators are diligently investigating this case and are hopeful the extension of this reward will bring forth witnesses who may have information related to Ms. Huerta’s suspicious disappearance.

The \$10,000 reward approved by this Board on September 30, 2020, expired on December 27, 2020, reestablished with the reward offer increased to \$20,000 on May 18, 2021, subsequently expired on August 15, 2021, reestablished on September 28, 2021, extended on December 7, 2021, extended on June 14, 2022, and is set to expire on December 21, 2022.

**I, THEREFORE, MOVE** that the Board of Supervisors extend the reward previously offered in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the suspect(s) whose willful heinous misconduct resulted in injury or death, and who are responsible for the suspicious disappearance of Gloria Huerta.
