Marina del Rey Holiday Boat Parade Fee Waiver

The 60th Annual Holiday Boat Parade was held in Marina del Rey on Saturday, December 10, 2022. The Marina del Rey Holiday Boat Parade organization is a volunteer-run, non-profit community organization that hosts an annual family-friendly holiday event for Marina del Rey residents and the broader Los Angeles County community. The theme for this year was “Sparkle on the Water” and tens of thousands of people attended to enjoy the festivities, which included live music, food trucks, shopping booths, fireworks, and a boat parade.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Instruct the Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors to retroactively waive (a) the \$1,166.25 visitors boat dock fees, (b) \$397.50 community building fees, and (c) \$160 for 20 parking spaces at parking lot #4, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for the 60th Annual Holiday Boat Parade that was held in Marina del Rey on Saturday, December 10, 2022.
