ORDINANCE NUMBER NO. 2023-0014Z

An ordinance amending County Code, Title 22 – Planning and Zoning, Section 22.06.060, changing regulations for execution of the Countywide General Plan, relating to Zoned District Numbers 15, 41, 44, 58, 60, and 64.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 22.06.060 is amended by amending the map of the following Zoned Districts: Stark Palms No. 15, Central Gardens No. 41, Roosevelt Park No. 44, Gage-Holmes No. 58, Compton-Florence No. 60, and Firestone Park No. 64, as shown on the attached map.

SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors finds that the ordinance is consistent with the Florence-Firestone Community Plan and the Countywide General Plan of the County of Los Angeles.

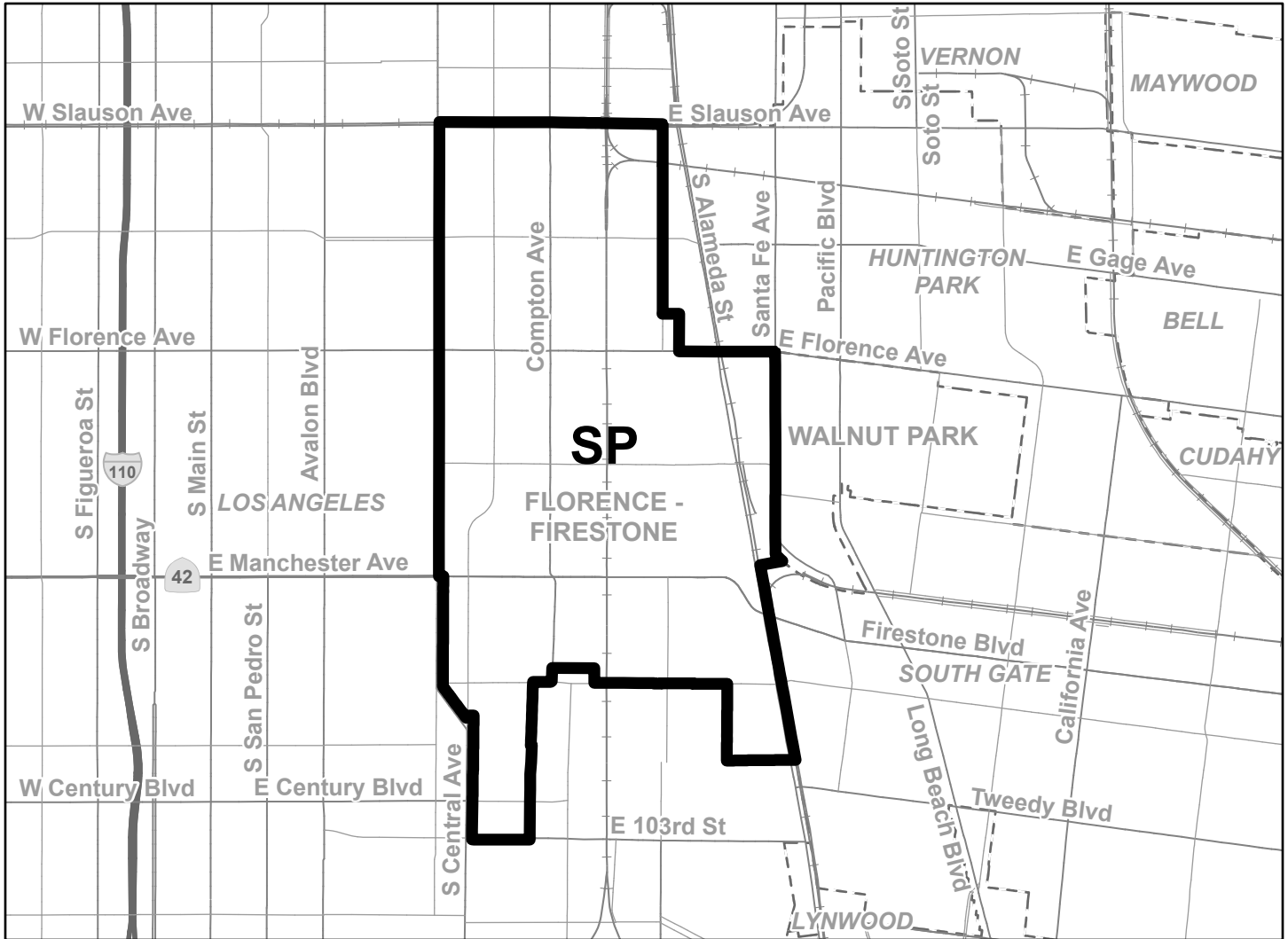

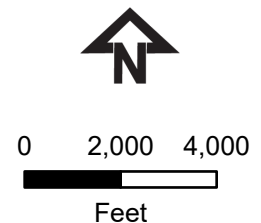
