Re-establish the Reward Offer in the Murder of Keith Jackson

On Thursday, December 29, 2016, at approximately 8:13 p.m., 43-year-old Keith Jackson and two female adults were seated inside his vehicle, parked along the south curb near the 1700 block of East Alondra Boulevard, in the city of Compton. A vehicle pulled up alongside them, and the front passenger of the suspect vehicle opened fire on Mr. Jackson as he was seated in the driver's seat. He sustained a single gunshot wound to the head and was transported to a local hospital, where he succumbed to his injury.

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) Homicide Investigators believe there are residents in the neighborhood and surrounding area that may have seen or who may know the identity of the driver and/or the shooter in this incident. The Board of Supervisors established this reward on June 6, 2023. This reward expired on September 3, 2023 and needs to be re-established. Any individuals with information about this crime are urged to contact LASD's Homicide Bureau or Crime Stoppers.
