## Reward Reestablishment in the Investigation of the Robbery at Rodeo Jewelers

On July 1, 2023, a violent robbery occurred mid-day at Rodeo Jewelers in the City of La Verne. Four suspects drove a vehicle into the store and then proceeded to conduct a smash and grab style robbery. It is estimated that the suspects took over \$300,000 worth of jewelry. During the robbery, at least one of the suspects assaulted an employee prior to all suspects departing in another vehicle. Law enforcement officials strongly believe that this robbery is linked to several other similar robberies in other cities within Los Angeles and Orange counties.

Unfortunately, smash and grab robberies have become all too common and have impacted many businesses across Los Angeles County. Therefore, to encourage members of the community who may have information about this incident to come forward, the City of La Verne authorized a reward in the amount of \$10,000 and the Board of Supervisors subsequently approved a matching \$10,000 reward.
