## CT3 Foundation Charity Polar Plunge Fee Waiver

The CT3 Foundation (CT3) is an organization committed to helping children with cancer and other life-altering medical conditions, as well those overcoming challenging circumstances. The organization raises funds to support families in their community directly and through partnerships with inspiring organizations. The Friendship Foundation (FF) is one of those inspiring organizations. FF is a South Bay 503(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to creating friendships and opportunities for people with special needs. Their mission is to support parents and families who have children and young adults with special needs by providing a safe, accepting, and inclusive environment where they can enjoy sports, art, music, and many other social programs with their peers. FF is currently in the process of building a 64,000-square foot facility in Redondo Beach that will offer vocational training and job placement to neurodivergent individuals.
