				Collaboration and Communication:	
				* **Streamline communication channels:** Establish clear and efficient communication channels between all participating agencies, including law enforcement, prosecutors, child welfare organizations, technology companies, and community groups. * **Regular meetings and information sharing:** Organize regular meetings for task force members to share information, coordinate investigations, and discuss emerging trends in online child exploitation. * **Standardized protocols and procedures:** Develop and implement standardized protocols for reporting, investigating, and prosecuting ICAC cases.
