Oppose	Monisha Parker	Here are some suggestions for strengthening the On-Call Architectural/Engineering and Support Services Agreements in Los Angeles County:  ***Improve Communication and Transparency:**  ****Clear communication about contract expectations:** Ensure clear and written communication about scope of services, expected response times, payment terms, and performance standards.  ***Regular communication channels:** Establish regular communication channels for exchanging information, updates, and potential concerns between County departments and firms.  ***Performance evaluation and feedback:** Implement a formal process for evaluating firm performance after each project and providing constructive feedback to inform future collaborations.  ***Public disclosure of awarded contracts: ** Consider publicly disclosing information about awarded contracts, including scope of work, fees, and firm qualifications, to enhance transparency.  ***Promote Competition and Affordability:**  ***Diversify pool of qualified firms:** Encourage participation from a wider range of qualified firms, especially small businesses and minority-owned businesses, through outreach and streamlined application processes.  ***Tiered pricing structures:** Explore tiered pricing structures based on project size and complexity to cater to diverse needs and budgets.  ***Competitive selection process:** Explore tiered pricing structures based on project size and competitive selection process based on pre-defined criteria beyond just cost, considering qualifications, experience, and project-specific expertise.  ***Strengthen Collaboration and Teamwork:**  ****Collaborative workshops and forums:** Organize workshops or forums where County departments and firms can collaborate on project planning, share best practices, and address potential challenges.  ***Joint project teams:** Consider forming joint project teams with representatives from the County and collaborating firms to foster communication, alignment, and problem-solving.  ***Enhance Efficiency and Streaml	

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			***Standardized contract templates:** Utilize standardized contract templates with clear terms and conditions, minimizing negotiation time and streamlining the process.  **Online project management tools:** Implement online project management tools for efficient communication, document sharing, and task tracking.  **Automated payment processes:** Explore automating payment processes to minimize delays and administrative burdens.  **Sustainability and Innovation:**  ***Encourage sustainable design practices:** Include criteria for incorporating sustainable design principles into proposals and project evaluations.  ***Incentivize innovative solutions:** Encourage firms to propose innovative approaches that address project challenges and offer long-term cost savings or benefits.  ***Regular review and update:** Regularly review and update the agreement based on performance feedback, industry trends, and emerging technologies.  **Additional Considerations:**  ***Equity and inclusion:** Ensure the selection process and project opportunities promote equity and inclusion for firms from diverse backgrounds.  ***Community engagement:** Consider opportunities for community involvement in project planning and implementation, where appropriate.  ***Data-driven decision making:** Utilize data collected during project execution to inform future contract terms, selection criteria, and performance expectations.
