				Here are some suggestions for strengthening As-Needed On-Site Veterinary Services Contracts in Los Angeles County:	
				Clarity and Specificity:	
				 ***Clearly define services:** Explicitly outline the types of services covered under the contract, including emergency care, spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations, specific procedures, and consultations. ***Standardize deliverables:** Establish clear expectations for deliverables associated with each service, including response times, turnaround times, reports, and follow-up procedures. ***Specify selection criteria:** Implement well-defined and objective criteria for selecting veterinarians under the contract, focusing on qualifications, experience, relevant expertise, and emergency response capabilities. 	
				Improved Payment Structures:	
				* **Consider tiered pricing:** Explore tiered pricing structures based on service complexity, urgency, and travel distance to ensure affordability and fair compensation for veterinarians. * **Performance-based incentives:** Implement performance-based incentives that reward veterinarians for exceeding expectations, like high client satisfaction ratings, timely service delivery, and cost-effectiveness. * **Streamlined payment processes:** Automate payment processes whenever possible to minimize delays and administrative burdens for both parties.
