				* ***Clearly define program goals and performance metrics:** Ensure the contract outlines specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, and time-bound (SMART) goals for program outcomes, such as reducing hospitalizations, increasing medication adherence, and improving independent living skills. * **Evidence-based treatment practices:** Require providers to utilize evidence-based treatment modalities tailored to the specific needs of the target population. * **Data-driven program evaluation:** Conduct regular program evaluations to assess progress towards achieving goals, identify areas for improvement, and inform future program design. * **Client-centered services:** Ensure the program focuses on individual client needs and preferences, offering personalized treatment plans and support services. * **Continuity of care:** Collaborate with other service providers to ensure smooth transitions between different levels of care and support continuity of treatment.
