		Oppose	Monisha Parker	<p>The fee waivers are typically granted based on specific criteria and eligibility requirements, and they are not negotiable.</p> <p>However, there are a few other options you might consider:</p> <p>**1. Check if you qualify for an existing fee waiver:** The Run Malibu website doesn't mention any specific fee waiver programs, but it's worth checking with the organizers directly to see if they offer any waivers based on financial hardship, volunteer work, or other factors. You can contact them through their website or social media channels.</p> <p>**2. Look for fundraising opportunities:** Some races offer discounted or even free entry to participants who raise a certain amount of money for charity. Check if the Run Malibu has any such programs and, if so, how you can participate.</p> <p>**3. Consider alternative races:** If the Run Malibu fee is outside your budget, there might be other half marathons or 5Ks in Los Angeles County with lower entry fees. You can search online race calendars or running websites to find events that fit your budget and preferences.</p> <p>**4. Volunteer at the event:** While you wouldn't get to participate in the race itself, volunteering at the Run Malibu could be a rewarding experience and allow you to be part of the event in a different way. Some races offer free or discounted entry to volunteers in exchange for their help.</p>
