Define Shared Goals and Clear Responsibilities:  Clarity: The MOU should clearly outline the goals for expanding services and detail how they align with existing policies and initiatives in the county.  Roles: Identify the specific roles and responsibilities of each agency or organization involved in providing services.  Accountability: Include performance metrics and reporting requirements to track progress and maintain accountability throughout the process.  2. Prioritize Collaboration and Coordination:  Community Organizations: Partner with immigrant-serving organizations and community leaders to better understand their needs and leverage their expertise.  Cross-Sector Collaboration: Foster partnerships between government agencies, service providers, legal aid organizations, and other relevant stakeholders. 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		Legal Assistance: Expand pro-bono legal aid, 'Know Your Rights' workshops, and legal resources for immigrants navigating complex immigration processes.
		Healthcare: Address disparities in healthcare access for immigrants, including translation services and connections to affordable health insurance options.
		Social Services: Increase support for immigrant families, including access to housing assistance, food programs, and other social safety net programs.
		Educational Support: Provide English language classes, educational resources for immigrant children, and support for parents navigating the school system.
		5. Address Barriers to Access:
		Fear and Mistrust: Conduct outreach to address fears associated with accessing government services due to immigration status. Clarify confidentiality policies and promote a safe environment.
		Transportation: Consider providing transportation assistance or partnering with organizations that offer subsidized transportation to services.
