Refining Contractual Language: *Clear Service Standards:Clearly define **specific service expectations** in the contract, including cleaning frequency, quality standards, and response times for addressing concerns. Performance Measurement:Establish **objective and measurable performance metrics** to assess contractor compliance with service standards. This allows for data-driven monitoring and enforcement. Green Cleaning Provisions: Include **clauses encouraging environmentally friendly cleaning practices**, such as the use of non-toxic cleaning products and water-saving methods. Living Wage Requirements: Consider including **provisions for fair wages and benefits** for custodial staff employed by the contracted companies. This promotes economic justice and improves employee morale, potentially leading to better service quality. Transparency and Accountability:Ensure clear procedures for **reporting concerns, resolving disputes, and enforcing contractual obligations**. 2.
