Contact the Medical Examiner's office to inquire about any potential discounts or financial assistance programs that may be available for individuals who are unable to afford the full fee.</li> <li>2. Request a detailed breakdown of the fees and charges associated with the transportation and storage services provided by the Medical Examiner's office. This can help identify any unnecessary or excessive charges that can be contested or negotiated.</li> <li>3. Explore alternative transportation and storage options, such as arranging for private transportation or storage services, which may be more cost-effective than using the services provided by the Medical Examiner's office.</li> <li>4. Consider enrolling in a pre-paid funeral or burial plan, which may include coverage for transportation and storage services provided by the Medical Examiner's office.</li> <li>5.
