from April 1, 2024 through April 6, 2024 in neighborhoods across Los Angeles County. The following five-days of action will highlight the partnerships that create healthier, stronger, and safer communities.

- April 1, 2024, will celebrate the achievements of the LA County Heart Heroes campaign and unveil the next milestone for the initiative.
- April 2, 2024, will consist of gun locks distribution at a community event in collaboration with the Department of Health Services.
- April 3, 2024, the Parent Café will be launched, where parents and caregivers
 of children with special needs come together.
- April 4, 2024, will focus on a youth advocacy event featuring training on Narcan use and Hands Only CPR.
- April 5, 2024, will feature a youth leadership program in collaboration with County Parks and Recreation and celebrate a Transgender Day of Visibility.
- April 6, 2024, the Whittier Wellness Center will be launched.

Public Health invites all County residents to attend these events to learn about and discuss important public health issues such as health equity, violence prevention, environmental justice, communicable disease, and other topics of interest to the community.
