				I am writing to express my deep concern regarding the proposed increase in billing rates for the Department of Public Health Laboratory Services. As a resident of this county, I believe that affordable healthcare is a fundamental right that should be accessible to all, regardless of their socioeconomic status.
				The proposed rate increase would disproportionately burden uninsured residents, who already face significant financial challenges. Many of these individuals rely on the Department of Public Health Laboratory Services for essential diagnostic tests, such as blood work and screenings, that are crucial for maintaining their health and well-being.
