Biddy Mason Charitable Foundation Foster Youth Resource Fair Fee Waiver

In 2013, the Biddy Mason Charitable Foundation (Foundation) began as an outreach ministry of the First African Methodist Episcopal (First AME) Church of Los Angeles. In 2016, the Foundation became an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that is dedicated to serving current and former foster youth in Los Angeles County through innovative programs and collaborative initiatives with community partners.

On Saturday, May 4, 2024, the Foundation, in partnership with the Departments of Beaches and Harbors, Children and Family Services, and Sheriff's Department Marina del Rey Station, are hosting a Foster Youth Resource Fair at Burton Chase Park in Marina del Rey. The event is expected to connect about 100 foster youth directly to resources and services. The Foundation requests that the facility and parking fees be retroactively waived for the event.
