LA COUNTY SCHOOLS DATA COLLECTION

At the April 30, 2024 Board of Supervisors meeting, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) made a presentation to the Board of Supervisors on the state of LAUSD, homelessness, and its impact on LAUSD, foster youth, and LGBTQIA+ youth. Given that the County of Los Angeles is home to 80 public school districts that serve 1.3 million elementary through high school students and in the spirit of inclusivity, it is important to hear from any of those school districts that wish to provide similar data/information to this Board.

I, THEREFORE, REQUEST the Superintendent of the Los Angeles County Office of Education, to survey all school districts in the County of Los Angeles, and report back to the Board of Supervisors in six months, with information voluntarily received from all interested school districts on the issues presented to us by LAUSD at our April 30th meeting, including homelessness prevention, chronic absenteeism, traffic safety measures near schools, foster youth, and LGBTQIA+ youth, and other matters as appropriate.
