ORDER OF ELECTION OF THE BALDWIN PARK UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA BIENNIAL GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER CONSOLIDATED ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Election shall be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, and the polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the District the question of whether four (4) members shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Baldwin Park Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for the holding of the above-mentioned election; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Park Unified School District will pay the costs of the election, and if any agency holds an election on November 5, 2024, the Baldwin Park Unified School District shall pay its pro-rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election, and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) §5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304, and §5322; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the District is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.

CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS - NOVEMBER 5, 2024

WHEREAS, Election Code, Section 13307 permits a local agency to require payment in advance of each candidate's pro rata share of the printing, handling, and mailing costs of their candidate statement as a condition of having it included in the voter's sample ballot pamphlet. A district also has the option of increasing the word limit for these statements from 200 to 400; and

WHEREAS, the District determines payment is required in advance, the office of the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk will estimate the cost and will collect the fee at the time the candidate statement is filed. If the actual cost exceeds the estimate, an invoice will be mailed after the election for payment of the balance due; and

WHEREAS, the District elects not to have candidates pay in advance, cost of the statement will be considered an election cost and charged against the District pursuant to Section 5420, et seq. of the Education Code. The District may then, pursuant to the Governing Board's policy, collect from the candidate or bear the cost, if not reimbursed; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Park Unified School District on December 9, 1998 adopted Board Bylaw 9220, Board of Education Elections, which states that "The District shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating or mailing candidate statements filed pursuant to Election Code 13307. The Board secretary shall notify the County Clerk/Vice President of this policy on or before the 125th day before each Board member election (Election Code 10509). Candidate statements shall be limited to no more than 200 words."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Baldwin Park Unified School District Board of Education has placed a maximum word limitation of 200 words per candidate statement and payment of the estimated cost must be made by the candidate at the time of filing.
