				I am writing to express my concern about the Wastewater Revenue Program Fiscal Year 2024-25 service charge for the Newhall Ranch Sanitation District of Los Angeles Bounty. While I understand the need for revenue to maintain and improve our wastewater infrastructure, I believe the current proposed service charge poses a significant financial burden on residents and businesses in our community.
				I urge you to consider the following strategies to make the service charge more affordable:
