				I am writing to request that you reduce the 2024 LAUSD Superintendent's Opening of Schools Address Fee Waiver from \$20 per vehicle to \$10 per vehicle.
				As you know, the annual Opening of Schools Address is an important event for the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) and the entire Los Angeles community. It is an opportunity for the Superintendent to share his vision for the district and to highlight the progress that has been made over the past year.
				However, the current fee waiver of \$20 per vehicle is a financial burden for many families. For many families, this fee represents a significant expense, especially when combined with the cost of parking and other expenses associated with attending the event.
				Reducing the fee waiver to \$10 per vehicle would make it more affordable for families to attend the Opening of Schools Address. This would allow more families to participate in this important event and to hear the Superintendent's vision for the future of LAUSD.
