1-D.		Oppose	Dakota Kelley Paul Charles C Burt	Inglewood's Mayor is already advertising 7 huge housing developments bringing 1,820 units to an already overcrowded area of 9.1 square miles. I am opposed to the Board approving an additional 120 unit development on the corner of LaBrea and Centinela. California is subjected to earthquakes and this overcrowding places the community at risk for cutting off major paths to leave the area or receive emergency response. Denser the population means higher the daily crime. Inglewood currently does not have the space nor infrastructure for another housing development this magnitude. Inglewood Unified School District has closed 8 of their schools since 2019. There is only one hospital serving the area with reported 299 beds (and the hospital is slated to close many units like Labor and Delivery this year). The Board must act responsibly and NOT waive the requirements of the California Quality Act when considering this project. There is not enough parks and open spaces for people to live comfortably and the community deserves a clean air impact report due to the multiple high rises planned for such a little area. Sanikofa Global Reality is not charging affordable rents for the working class raising a family with their current properties. Reviewing their website, a modest 725 sq ft apt, located on Hyde Park Avenue, Inglewood, is renting for \$1799.00. A very modest 700 sq ft. apt, on 6th Avenue, Inglewood, is renting for \$2100.00. This is not affordable – especially when taxpayers are supplying the \$65,000,000 bond for building. Please vote NO for this project.
