				I am writing to express my opposition to Item 26 of the Various LA County Library Restroom Refurbishment Projects. While I support the necessary improvements to our library facilities, I am deeply concerned about the lack of transparency and consistency in the proposed budget for these projects.
				Specifically, I am troubled by the fact that the Internal Services Department has submitted three different cost estimates for the restroom refurbishments. This discrepancy raises serious questions about the department's ability to provide accurate and reliable financial information.
				Furthermore, I believe that the proposed budget of \$686,000 for each library restroom refurbishment is excessive. County residents expect responsible and affordable spending, and this figure seems disproportionate to the scope of the renovations. We need a clear and consistent budget summary that outlines the cost of each project in a transparent and justifiable manner.
				I urge the Board of Supervisors to scrutinize the proposed budget for Item 26 and demand a detailed explanation of the cost discrepancies. I believe that a budget that is both transparent and affordable is essential to ensure that these vital public services are provided effectively and efficiently.
