5		Оррозе	Monisha Tarker	I am writing to express my concern regarding the issue of homeless encampments in Los Angeles County, particularly in the aftermath of the Grants Pass. I am deeply worried that the lack of a countywide strategy for addressing encampments will result in homeless people being moved around to the city of Los Angeles. As you are aware, the homelessness crisis in Los Angeles County is a complex and multifaceted issue that requires a comprehensive and coordinated response. The Executive Director of the Homeless Initiative and the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) play critical roles in developing and implementing strategies to address homelessness in our communities. However, I believe that a countywide approach is necessary to effectively address the issue of encampments. Without a countywide strategy, I fear that cities may resort to moving homeless individuals and families to other jurisdictions, rather than addressing the root causes of homelessness. This approach will only exacerbate the problem and create a cycle of displacement that will ultimately harm the most vulnerable members of our society. I urge you to take immediate action to develop a countywide strategy for addressing encampments. This strategy should prioritize providing permanent supportive housing, access to healthcare and mental health services, and job training and placement programs. It should also include measures to prevent the displacement of homeless individuals and families and ensure that all cities in Los Angeles County are held accountable for their role in addressing this crisis. The homelessness crisis in Los Angeles County requires a collaborative and comprehensive approach. I urge you to take the lead in developing a countywide strategy for addressing encampments and ensuring that all members of our community have access to the resources and support they need to thrive.
