WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Charter for the City of Inglewood a General Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the election of certain elective officers for the City of Inglewood and Inglewood Unified School District Board of Education:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the Charter, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Inglewood, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing the following elective officers for the City of Inglewood and Inglewood Unified School District Board of Education:

- 1. A Council Member from District No. 3 for a full term of four years;

6. School Board Member No. 5 from Trustee Area 5 for a full term of four years;

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 3. That the polls (vote centers) for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the date of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls (vote centers) shall be closed, pursuant to Elections Code section 10242, except as provided in sections 14212, 4005, and 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 4. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 5. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
