

Reestablish the Reward Offer in the Murder of Eric Brown

On Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at approximately 11:32 p.m., 12-year-old Eric Gregory Brown III was walking on the sidewalk with friends near the 2200 block of Lewis Avenue in Long Beach when he was approached by a vehicle containing at least two male suspects and shot multiple times. He was transported to a local hospital by Long Beach Fire Department personnel, along with a 14-year-old female victim who was also shot. Tragically, Eric’s injuries were life-threatening, and he passed away.

The reward expired on August 27, 2024, and investigators believe it would be beneficial to reestablish the reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individual(s) responsible for this crime.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reestablish the offer of a reward in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of 12-year-old Eric Gregory Brown III, who was fatally shot on the 2200 block of Lewis Avenue in Long Beach on May 9, 2023, at approximately 11:32 p.m.
