RE: Transmittal of Certified Copies of Resolution Nos. 2024-R048 and 2024-R049, Calling and Giving Notice of and Requesting the Board of Supervisors to Consolidate a Culver City's General Municipal Election on November 5, 2024 and Resolution 2007-R068, providing for a 200 word candidate statement and payment requirement by Candidates.

As the Elections Official of the City of Culver City, and in accordance with the provisions of the City Council Resolutions mentioned above, I am pleased to transmit herewith certified copies of Resolution Nos. 2024-R048, 2024-R049, adopted by the City Council on June 24, 2024.

Resolution 2024-R049 contains the City Council's request to the Board of Supervisors to consent and agree to the consolidation of the General Municipal Election (called by the City Council's adoption of Resolution 2024-R048 on June 24, 2024) with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

Resolution No. 2024-R048 submits to the voters a request to elect three (3) City Council seats during the November 5, 2024 General Municipal Election.

1 SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles
2 is hereby further respectfully requested to place upon the same ballot as that
3 provided for said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los
4 Angeles on November 5, 2024, the names of the candidates for the office of
5 Council Member, with three seats available, each for a full four-year term.

6 SECTION 3: That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los
7 Angeles is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to canvass the returns of
8 the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there
9 were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

10 SECTION 4. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue
11 instructions to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles
12 to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

13 SECTION 5. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the
14 Elections Code, the City Council respectfully requests the Board of Supervisors of
15 the County of Los Angeles to authorize and permit the Registrar-Recorder/County
16 Clerk of the County of Los Angeles to:

17 a. Print and supply ballots for said City of Culver City General
18 Municipal Election;

19 b. Mail the City's voter information guides and candidate
20 statements of qualifications to the electors of the City of Culver City as part
21 of the same material that will be mailed to the voters of the Statewide
22 General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles;

23 c. Perform such other services as may be required for the
24 consolidation and conduct of said City of Culver City General Municipal
25 Election with said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of
26 Los Angeles.

27 SECTION 6. That the City of Culver City recognizes that additional
28 costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this request and agrees to

1 reimburse the County for any costs for such services when the work is completed
2 and after submission of an approved invoice, which shall be processed in
3 accordance with City's normal demand procedure.

4 SECTION 7. That the City Clerk is directed and authorized to file a
5 certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los
6 Angeles and to transmit an electronic copy to the Board of Supervisors and the
7 Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles.

8 SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and
9 adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

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

SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

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1 SECTION 2. FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY.

2 A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, the City is required to
3 translate candidates' statements into Spanish.

4 B. The City Clerk, or designee, shall print all translations of all
5 candidates' statements in the main voter pamphlet. The main voter pamphlet
6 shall be in English and Spanish.

8 SECTION 3. PAYMENT.

9 A. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating
10 the candidate's statement into any required foreign language, as required by
11 subsection A of Section 2 (above) pursuant to Federal law.

12 B. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing
13 the candidate's statement in English in the main voter pamphlet.
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15 C. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing
16 the candidate's statement in a foreign language, as required by subsection A
17 of Section 2 (above), in the main voter pamphlet.

18 The City Clerk, or designee, shall estimate the total cost of printing, handling,
19 translating, and mailing the candidate's statements filed pursuant to this section, including
20 costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (as amended),
21 and require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance to the local agency his or
22 her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the
23 voter's pamphlet. In the event the estimated payment is required, the estimate is just an
24 approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may
25 be significantly more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of
26 candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the City Clerk, or designee, is not bound by the
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1 estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or
2 refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment,
3 the City Clerk, or designee, may require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost
4 incurred. In the event of overpayment, the City Clerk, or designee, shall prorate the excess
5 amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within 30 days of the
6 election.

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8 SECTION 4. That this resolution shall apply at the next ensuing municipal
9 election and at each municipal election after that time.

10 SECTION 5. Resolution 95-R104 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 4. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the Election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding general municipal elections.



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

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R068

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 95-R104.

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidate's statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

That pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at an Election to be held in the City of Culver City may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk, or designee. The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself. The statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. The statement shall be filed in typewritten form in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. The statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

1 SECTION 2. FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY.

2 A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, the City is required to

4 B. The City Clerk, or designee, shall print all translations of all



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
