Re: Item 29 - Bridging Resource Gaps in the Antelope Valley

Dear Honorable Board of Supervisors:

We applaud the work set forth in Item 29 to build equity and raise visibility to the resources available in the Antelope Valley. Prior to adoption of the motion, however, we urge you to specifically name and include the Los Angeles County Aging and Disabilities Department as a key partner in the equity work. The California Commission in Aging recently elevated the California Budget and Policy Center findings that "poverty is highest for adults ages 65 and older, at 20.6%" in 2023 versus 18.4% in 2022. Work must be done at the local level to ensure visibility of resources and reduce barriers to services for all older adults. Adding the Aging and Disabilities Department will promote the economic security of older adults living the in the Antelope Valley. Thank you for your consideration of this request. We look forward to using the equity tools developed under item 29 to enhance legal services to residents of the Antelope Valley.
