

Extend a Reward Offer in the Investigation of Murder Victim Carlos Alvarez-Diaz

On Saturday, October 8, 2022, at approximately 1:09 a.m., 40-year-old Carlos Alvarez-Diaz was shot while he drove north on Norwalk Boulevard at 226th Street in the city of Hawaiian Gardens. Mr. Alvarez-Diaz sustained a gunshot wound to the upper torso and died from his injuries. A 14-year-old was also struck by gunfire but survived. The victim was a working man and had a family. His family also has ties to the Hawaiian Gardens City Council.

Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department investigators believe that extending the reward would bring more attention to the case and encourage witnesses that might have seen and/or know the identity of the suspect(s) to come forward and the reward would show urgency in identifying the suspect(s) and bring justice to the victim and his family.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors extend the \$20,000 reward in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the heinous murder of Carlos Alvarez-Diaz, who was fatally shot on October 8, 2022, at approximately 1:09 a.m., while driving north on Norwalk Boulevard at 226th Street in the city of Hawaiian Gardens.
