City of Malibu Homeless Outreach Parking Fee Waiver 2024

In the City of Malibu, The People Concern (TPC) has been the primary provider of services for people experiencing homelessness (PEH) since 2018. Made up of two outreach workers, a housing navigator, and a program manager, the TPC Outreach Team offers a variety of services, including enrollment in a comprehensive care system and housing placement. The team conducts regular field visits throughout the city and surrounding beaches, including the Zuma Beach parking lot, to engage both new and chronically homeless individuals. TPC also partners with the nonprofit organization, Venice Family Clinic, and the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to deliver street medicine services to Malibu's PEH population. In close coordination with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the City of Malibu, these efforts have successfully helped many individuals transition into temporary or permanent housing, while also supporting cleanup initiatives and improving public safety.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE, that the Board of Supervisors instruct the Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors to waive the cost of an estimated \$10,644.00 in parking fees at the Zuma Beach parking lot, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for
