

Establish a Reward Offer for the Murder of Jose Manuel Rangel

On May 14, 2023, at approximately 4:00 p.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) deputies responded to a gunshot victim call for service near the 5400 block of Clara Street in the city of Cudahy. Upon arrival, deputies canvassed the immediate area for a victim. Deputies located a male, Hispanic, adult lying on the sidewalk of the Clara Street Bridge, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Los Angeles County Fire Department personnel arrived on scene and pronounced the male victim deceased at 4:20 p.m.

The victim was identified as Jose Manuel Rangel, a resident of Bell, who was in the area visiting his mother for Mother's Day. At the time Victim Rangel was murdered, he was riding his bicycle on the Clara Street Bridge after visiting his mother. While traveling on the bridge, Victim Rangel was involved in an altercation with two males. At some point during the altercation, Victim Rangel ran east on Clara Street, away from the two males. One of the males produced a handgun and fired several rounds at Victim Rangel, striking him. The males fled west on Clara Street. There were no witnesses to the shooting. Victim Rangel left behind his father, mother, stepmother, and sister.

LASD Homicide Investigators have been unable to determine a motive for the murder, and unable to identify any suspects. Homicide Investigators are requesting a
