**Public Comment for Board Meeting - Item #12**

**Carlos Vaquerano, President & CEO, Clínica Monséñor Oscar A. Romero**

Dear Board of Supervisors,

My name is Carlos Vaquerano, and I am the CEO of Clínica Monséñor Oscar A. Romero. I am here today to speak in support of Item #12.

I want to first express my sincere gratitude to Supervisor Hilda Solis for bringing this important motion forward to eliminate the Department of Medical Examiner's transportation and storage fee. This motion addresses a critical issue affecting so many in our community, especially among our low-income residents who already face significant financial hardship.
