Establish the Reward Offer in the Murder of Raejonette Laveda Morgan

On Tuesday, July 2, 2024, at approximately 7:45 p.m., 23-year-old Raejonette Laveda Morgan, a sole occupant in a white Mercedes, was driving southbound on Vermont Avenue, approaching the 105 West on-ramp entrance, when a suspect in a blue sedan drove up next to the vehicle on the driver’s side. The suspect shot at the vehicle several times, striking Ms. Morgan. The Mercedes then crashed into the corner of Vermont Avenue, and the 105 on-ramp. The suspect continued south on Vermont Avenue.

Ms. Morgan sustained several gunshot wounds. She was transported to the hospital, but succumbed to her injuries on July 4, 2024. Investigators believe the shooting was gang-related, but Ms. Morgan was not the intended target. Ms. Morgan was employed and in school at the time of her death. She is survived by her parents and two brothers who are devastated by her loss.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department (LASD) Homicide detectives believe there are witnesses in the neighborhood who may have seen the suspect(s) leave the area or possibly know their identities and that a reward by the Board of Supervisors would assist in solving this case. Any individuals with information about this senseless crime are urged to contact the LASD Homicide Bureau or Crime Stoppers.
