WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH MARCH 2025

This recognition began in 1978, when the Sonoma School District held a weeklong celebration of Women's Contributions to Society. In 1980, President Jimmy Carter issued the first Presidential proclamation declaring March 2-8 as National Women's History Week. A special Presidential Proclamation is issued every year which honors the extraordinary achievements of American women.
