Upon walking into 4800, the module appeared cleaner than previous visits (including the stairs, hallway, lack of trash around – though there was still a smoke smell and two fires in cells seen by inspectors). It was noted to the Commissioners that Sheriff Luna was visiting MCJ at the same time, explaining the change in condition. In 4800B, not all the cell doors were fully working and were either jammed or completely unlocked. Commissioners talked with two individuals in the hallway of a row, as their door was completely open (and broken). Deputies on the floor were aware of the ongoing door issue. Multiple cells had phones that were inoperable (stated for months), and there was no hot water in the unit shower. Commissioners heard about the lack of hot water from multiple individuals who reported the issue was ongoing. Individuals also had limited access to the showers, complaining that they were going a week without showering at times due to deputies not allowing them out to the shower. Multiple individuals in the module complained that a search was conducted and their property was taken, including photos, letters, phone number cards, and commissary items. Individuals requested wipes during the flu season to avoid the spread of germs but were not provided the requested wipes or cleaning products; a row noted they had just gotten through the flu and were requesting sanitation/clean up and did not receive it. Individuals complained they were not receiving enough food showing Commissioners two slices of bread with no bologna or filling inside whatsoever for lunch. Individuals complained of the rise in commissary prices twice a year and how expensive items were for purchase. Individuals did not have access to grievance forms and Commissioners requested Deputies pass out forms and stayed until forms were provided to all requested.

In 5800, individuals complained that only 1 of the 6 phones were working when 100 individuals are housed in the unit. An individual was observed sitting on a mattress with a mask over his face next to the restroom. It was reported that this individual did not have a bed and was recently arrived to the form. When reported to the Deputy, Commissioners were told often people do not choose to sit on their bed but the Deputy was asked to confirm this individual did in fact have access to a bed in the unit and to communicate it to him. SBC did not hear follow-up. The temperature in the unit was reported to be extremely cold, especially in the morning and the water in the showers remains too hot. One shower head runs all day long and multiple showers have rust and mold. One of the toilets in the unit has leaked constantly for months. Individuals reported waiting weeks for hormone treatments and lacking access to panties and bras in a variety of sizes, as well as feminine items like mascara, combs, or other hygiene items. High protein meals were not being given to those who were authorized them by medical and food was overall arriving cold and not in sufficient quality as reported by multiple individuals. Many reports of hunger across the dorm. Individuals did not have access to grievance forms and similar to the other unit, Commissioners requested and stayed until a Deputy passed out forms to individuals in the unit. Although a netting was placed at the unit door for purposes of nurses speaking to individuals during pill calls, individuals complained that Deputies and nurses were calling out “Come and get your __ pill”, sharing personal medical information that they did not want to be shared with others out – violating HIPAA. This was reported to the Watch Commander Lt. Bengston and the on-duty Medical Supervisor, who told the Commissioners that proper training was ongoing to medical staff and would be reinforced.

In 1750G, an individual complained of a flooding toilet and blocked their vent with toilet paper because the cell was too cold. The individual requested they be moved and the request was communicated to the Deputy, who confirmed it would be completed as soon as another cell became available. Cell 4 had a window that was so dirty the Commissioners could not observe the conditions of the cell inside, but the individual complained of tagging and the cell being extremely dirty. Overall, 1750G was the cleanest commissioners had ever seen it.

52. Inspection Detail for #:

We went to the 8000 floor where we inspected several individual cells; the incarcerated people there referred to that area as the horseshoe. They are people who have diabetes, some insulin-dependent diabetes, and kidney disease. They are in cells that do not have phones, TVs, or showers, so they reported they go to a day room scheduled three times per week, which does not always happen in the day room, a very small room we inspected. There are two telephones and one TV. There were 20 individual men in the dayroom when we were there, and it was very cramped.

53. Inspection Detail for #:

We went to 8030, another housing area, but they have TVs and phones in there, and is considered a step up from the horseshoe (which is for short-term people. We spoke to 2 people both of whom had been in that area for over 3 years each). Those are also people with diabetes. They showed us the chicken that had been served to them that night for dinner, and Mary smelled it and inspected it and it was rotten. 2 of 4 showers don't work and 2 of 4 phones aren't functional. There is an ant infestation in the shower in 8030. These were reported to the watch commander, and he put in work orders as we left.

54. Inspection Detail for #:

We observed a deputy scanning the doors in 8000 and an 8200 very quickly; they were not looking inside very quick security checks. Multiple people in 8030 reported that it is very cold and they only have sheets. Multiple people reported a new procedure whereby they are required to bend over and cough and drop their underwear in front of others every time they return to court. They thought this was very demeaning. They hoped the body scanners would be implemented soon because doing that in front of others is very upsetting. SBC would note that no kind of inspection occurs with staff or their property.

We noted that the hallway with a major flood in the ceiling of 8230 from a former inspection appears to be fixed -- good news.

- All incarcerated people in LA County jails screened for criminal and medical, and they must volunteer for the program after staff outreach to join. Some do decline.

the men are trained by LAFD only if they fill they have enough participants to make it "worth their while," and after a two week training from LAFD the men are transfer to a State Facility Camp temporarily. After this they would be certified for basic wildfire firefighting.

- They must be sentenced.

- The facility was exceptionally clean. there were multiple murals and the facility is partly remodeled for ADA occupancy to support if MCJ individuals needed to be transferred there once it finally shuts down.

OVERALL

- 3 compounds closed refurbishment to get the staff enclosed
- Each compound has 3 barracats/buildings
- Barracks are filled with 3 man bunks, barracks style, with porches and attached outdoor mini yard and phone area for the 3 barracks to share
- They can use the connected outdoor area approximately 1 hour at a time each day
- They do not have clocks in their barracks. There is only one clock in the yard area approximately 10 - 50 yards from their respective building depending on which they are in.
- They get yard time once a week
- Staff reported that there is very little tension between themselves and the people incarcerated there due to the housing set up, daily access to outdoor areas, cleaner conditions and the other "privileges" that come with being at the South facility compared to MCJ or even the North facility.
- Many of the outdoor phones do not work. The phone company informed the Sheriff's Department that it was due to significant damage to the in-ground lines for the phones.
- Sgt Walsh shared that there have been 2 overdoses in the last 5 years at this facility. He feels this is due to the incarcerated individual who "shoot calls" not allowing other incarcerated individuals to be in possession of fentanyl specifically.
- During our time at the facility, we saw many incarcerated workers or trustees. Green uniforms indicated inside workers, and yellow uniforms indicated outside workers.
- Incarcerated individuals here recently received a shingles vaccination. They were told that they could refuse, and if they did they would be but in quarantine. The men shared they have not seen anyone go to quarantine for this though.
- We saw NARCAN in all the barracks.
- Request form boxes were filled but some people shared it takes a long time to get responses.
- Have AC & heat in all occupied buildings.
- Overall the floors in the dwelling space was relatively clean in all barracks.
- Each compound we visited had ample cleaning solution.
- It is important to not that they do not provide speciality diets at this facility and if people need speciality diets they are transferred to a different facility.
- They have vending machines in the compound shared outdoor space and they individuals can purchase vending cards to acces them.

EIB

- There was a well attended EIB program
- When we were there, they were offering sociology, high school classes, and vocational classes (anger management) that day.
- The EBI program here is currently full. Each day they run multiple classes Monday through Friday. The high school classes run year round, Monday through Friday, and the college classes (through College of the Canyons) run Mondays and Wednesdays. The enrollment for high school classes is year round and the college classes are on the enrollment schedule of the year. Incarcerated individuals can enroll by asking a staff or filling out the request form.
- Sgt. Lopez (badge #8228) has been with the EIB Program for 13 years and deeply believes in the benefits of programs for the people inside. He shared the programing has still not recovered since the pandemic. Specifically they had an average of 35 teachers at South prior to the pandemic, and they currently have about 16 despite his and his team's efforts.
- The EIB team onsite shared that the men at the facility can continue their education through Coastline College even once they go home.
- If people are pre-trial, they cannot fully enroll, but they can do a 7 session milestone program.

107. Narrative Continued

REGARDNG EVACUATION

- Sgt Walsh heard from other people working that they didn't feel they needed to evacuate, but they did anyway because they felt that they had time on their side and could use that to have a more spacious time to have staff go through all the steps. They were able to evacuate effectively in one hour.
- They moved the incarcerated individuals to NCCF in the 600 building.
- Though St Walsh left right before they found out they had to evacuate, he remembered seeing at least 8 busses onsite at the time of his departure and he let us know that in a pinch they can also use the laundry busses to transport people with lower levels.
- He also shared that in his nearly 6 years at the South Facility, there had only ever been 1 fire on the property back in 2019, in which they lost one structure but no people were injured

ADAMS COMPOUND

- Only 6 of the 22 phones in their yard work.
- This recently caused strife between the incarcerated individuals at the Adams compound. Sgt Walsh shared there was a "riot" / "racial fight" / "incident" that occurred between Black and Latino incarcerated individuals in the yard on Tuesday, February 18, 2025. This incident was regarding the limited phone access in the shared outdoor space. The limited phone access is causing strife and safety concerns. Due to this incident there were no Black individuals in any of the Adams Compound. There were 80 - 100 people involved in the fight and 5 individuals had to seek medical attention following the incident.

*Adams - Building 33

- 1 out of 2 of the phones are broken. The phones are located very close to the showers and it is very likely that the moisture is damages the phones more quickly
- Contributing to this is that the water for the showers is way to hot and steams up about a quarter of the barracks, into the space with the men's bunks.
- One of the main complaints of the individuals housed in the 33 building was the exorbitant commissary pricing. As an example, they cited that a pack of soup is \$32 and \$8-9 for coffee.
- One person also uplifted that the 1 adult, 1 child limitation for visitation is specifically hard for him, because he has two kids. Luckily, when I mentioned this to Sgt. Walsh that as of this weekend (March 1, 2025), they will be increasing the visitation limit to 2 adults and 1 child, or 1 adult and 2 children.
- The people in this building complained that the water is too harsh and the shower curtain was visibly stained.
- The drinking water is mildly foggy when you originally put it in a container, but it clears up.
- Many people had complaints about the quality of the food and specifically what is in the meat.
- Consistent with the North facility, these people have to wake up at 2am to make their court dates. They shared frustration that if they have court at San Fernando or Van Nuys, they have to pass the courthouse to go to MCJ and then travel backwards.
- 5+ men shared that they estimate that they have missed the majority of their court dates, and when they do "bus issues" are cited. One man shared that he had been to two court dates in his 8 month time being incarcerated at South. Another man shared that even when he has made it, sometimes they are delayed and by the time he makes it to the court, his (paid) lawyer leaves because he cannot wait for him. Additionally, Ibarra (#6932537) shared that he has missed 2-3 court dates in the last 2.5 months.
- 4 additional Sheriffs came to this compound during our time talking to these men. Officer Gasca was specifically mindful to be where we were during the inspection of this compound, and gave commentary as we spoke to the incarcerated individuals.

*Building 32

- When they flush one of the urinals leaks
- 1 of the 2 phones in the barrack has a messed up cord
- 2 people shared they felt informed during the fire.
- There is no clock in the dorm.
- There is a pile of books in the barracks that one man was reading. They would like a more formal library and additional books.
- They shared that it takes at least 2 - 2.5 weeks for mail and often has delays. Two people (Chavarria #6946086 & Marquez #6948910) had a loved ones share that they sent mail the last week of January but he still hasn't received the mail.
- Count: 43
- Max: 90

*Building 31

- Both phones in this building worked after a technician came out and fixed it last week. They also have the issue of only having scalding hot water in this building and the steaminess and moisture is likely damaging the phones more often.
- They also complained of delayed mail.

CHOW HALL

- There was no residual food. The floors and the surfaces were clean. This is a testament to the incarcerated workers at this facility who keep that area clean.
- Each compound comes there to eat their hot meal each day.
- Sgt. Walsh shared that they used to have 1 Chow Hall but the recently opened a second one to serve the lower compounds and that had 2 major impacts: 1) cut the overall food time down from 3 hours to 1.5 hours, and 2) lessened the passing of contraband amongst individuals.

HENERY COMPOUND

- Only 6 of the 22 phones in their yard work.

*Building 43

- Not yet refurbished
- They had unpredictable water temperatures as well. 2 -3 minutes of hot water before it turns cold and then hot again f someone flushes.
- Some individuals felt the instructional video each morning was too long.
- Count: 52
- Max: 90

KING COMPOUND

- Only 1 of the 22 phones in their yard work.

*Building 46

- This building is dedicated to the START Program and very low level
- The people here shared they were having trouble recieing books from Amazon. Soecially Vargas #6723766
- One person shared they experienced a delay in their lawyer recieving his mail.
- Count: 33
