- I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors:
- 1) Direct CEO-HI to restore the following expenditures in the fiscal year 2025-26 Homeless Initiative Budget
  - a. Transitional Age Youth Items (Approximately \$7 million):
    - i. Coordinated Entry System: Regional Coordination Funding associated with 8 Regional Coordinators for Youth (page 1 of funding recommendations)
    - ii. Targeted Prevention: Youth Family Reconnection \$1,866,000 (page 5)
    - iii. Navigation: Housing Navigation Funding associated with housing navigation for TAY (page 10)
    - iv. Navigation: Campus Peer Navigation \$1,094,000 (page 10)
    - v. Transitional Housing for Special Populations: Host Homes for TAY \$967,000 (page 14)
  - b. Prevention Items (\$19,066,000 Budget):
    - i. Problem Solving: Problem Solving \$550,000 (page 4)
    - ii. Problem Solving: Administration \$48,000 (page 4)
    - iii. Targeted Prevention: Homeless Prevention Case Management & Financial Assistance (Families & Individuals) - \$15,605,000 (page 4)
    - iv. Targeted Prevention: Staff and Administration \$2,063,000 (page 5)
    - v. Targeted Prevention: Emergency Basic Support \$500,000 (page 6)

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- vi. Targeted Prevention: Housing Related Assistance \$300,000 (page 6)
- c. Prevention line items shall only be restored to the actual expenditure levels in fiscal-year 2024-25, not their budget level in fiscal-year 2024-25 which were \$19,066,000). CEO-HI shall determine actual expenditure levels.
- 2) Funding for the items indicated above shall come from the following line items:
  - a. Housing Acquisition: Housing Location \$5,000,000 (page 18)
  - b. Pathway Home Remaining funding needed to restore the above items after the use of \$5,000,000 from Housing Acquisition: Housing Location.

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
