Healing Arts is a global campaign developed by the Jameel Arts & Health Lab in partnership with the World Health Organization. It promotes awareness of the role of the arts in improving health outcomes through exhibitions, performances, public installations, media partnerships, and city-wide activations. Past projects include the Healing Arts Symposium at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Iraq Pavilion at the Venice Architecture Biennale, the Healing Arts Auction Series with Christie's, and the WHO75 Healing Arts Concert in Geneva.

Bringing this work to a local stage, Los Angeles County Arts and Health Week will highlight the powerful connection between the arts and well-being through a series of public events, performances, and discussions. This collaboration between LA Opera, Chair Pro Tem and Supervisor Hilda L. Solis, the Los Angeles County Department of Arts and Culture, Renée Fleming, the WHO Healing Arts initiative, and the Jameel Arts & Health Lab will culminate in an Arts and Health Summit at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion on Friday, June 13, 2025.
