On June 17, 2025, I received written notice from DCFS Civil Rights Unit Manager Catherine Dingman that my discrimination complaint was closed—not for lack of merit—but because I refused to waive my legal right to privacy. The County closed my case for refusing to release my personal records, even though such release is not required under California law.</p> <p>This is textbook retaliation for asserting my rights under:</p> <p>42 U.S.C. § 1983 (Civil Rights under color of law)</p> <p>ADA Title II (42 U.S.C. § 12132)</p> <p>Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act (29 U.S.C. § 794)</p> <p>California Government Code § 11135</p> <p>WIC § 10000</p> <p>Cal. I made it clear in writing: I DO NOT CONSENT to the release of my protected information.

The department retaliated by issuing a formal case closure notice—proof of obstruction and coercion.

THIS IS A CRISIS OF ACCOUNTABILITY. I have endured 11 years of abuse, denial, suppression, and trauma at the hands of this department and its court collaborators. Your silence, your inaction, and now, this retaliatory closure—all reinforce the systemic violations parents like me have endured.

I DEMAND:

1. Immediate investigation of DCFS Civil Rights Unit for procedural violations.
2. Public reprimand of all officials named in my complaint.
3. Reinstatement of my civil rights complaint without record consent requirement.
4. Reparations for me and my children for prolonged trauma and damages.
