I deeply appreciate the Supervisors' continued recognition of the critical role Foster Family Agencies (FFAs) like ours play in serving the children and families of Los Angeles County. Our FFA is dedicated to finding a way to continue operating, but we cannot be sustained without access to financial support in the short-term and the resolution of the underlying insurability issues in the long-term. Over the past year, the system has lost and will continue to lose high-quality experienced FFAs, resulting in disruption and trauma to the nearly 1,600 children and families served by FFAs in L.A. County. I respectfully ask the Board of Supervisors to approve this motion in order to maintain a robust continuum of care for thousands of children and families.
